

## Wicked OTT App Configuration / Install

1. Turn on firestick
2. Go to settings
3. Go to developer options
4. Go to device or fire tv - Make sure ADB and Apps from unknown sources are both turned ON
5. While you are in settings area make sure to go to apps section and delete any old Wicked apps you have installed previously.
6. Go back to main menu and click on the magnifying glass
7. Type in Downloader
8. Go onto the Downloader app
9. Enter URL <https://troypoint.com/fl> /click on Download
10. Click on install when its downloaded
11. Now you have FileLinked downloaded, go to main menu and open FileLinked
12. Enter the code 83225520 and click continue
13. Click the downloaded button for each app - **OTT Two Services App 1.1.6** App then VLC & MX Player
14. Once its downloaded, the icon will change to a play icon - click again to begin installation.
15. Once you have all apps downloaded and installed, go to main menu and open Premier Mod app.
16. You will then proceed by clicking edit and entering your Username and Password followed by apply.
17. MOVIES AND SERIES WILL NOT SHOW - YOU MUST EXIT APP - THEN GO TO SETTINGS OF DEVICE AND FORCE CLOSE APP, THEN OPEN APP BACK UP. Once you open app back up, the Medial Library will appear.
18. Once logged in, lets do some configuration settings to help you get started:
  - a. Click settings on left then click on Player:
    - i. In Player click delay before quick-switching channels and select switch instantly.
    - ii. Then select setup codec preferences and click codec settings followed by always use hardware codecs then do check on enable resolution fix followed by external player which you need to select VideoLAN (VLC).
    - iii. Back up, and in Player select network then broadcast buffer size which you can change depending on your internet speed, some may use standard or increased.
  - b. Go Back to main settings and select extended settings
    - i. Select Stream Technology and choose MPEG-TS
    - ii. In this section you can set a code for restricted content or child mode protection for adult content.
  - c. Go Back to main settings and select List Settings
    - i. The first selection will have adult content hidden, you can uncheck if you want It visible.
    - ii. If you wish as well as lock them by going back to extended settings and adding a 4 digit code for restricted content or setting up child mode.
    - iii. Click item description at the bottom then change show selected video preview in description to not limited and then enable sound in video preview in description. This should allow video preview as your going through guide.

- d. To lock channels if you created a 4 digit pin in extended settings you simply go to main menu then click live stream then go to category and long press followed by action with all channels.
- e. Picture-in-Picture (only if you have additional connections) go to channel and open it then long press your center button and wait for menu to pop up. You can select picture-in-picture and either do studio mode or picture-in-picture.
  - i. In studio mode you will be displayed with current channel, to add more channels just press center button/enter button and add screen. You can continue this till you reached the desired amount of screens you want. **REMEMBER YOU CAN ONLY USE THE AMOUNT OF SCREENS YOU PURCHASED.**
  - ii. Once you have reached your desired limit you can press the left button on remote and it will bring up one main screen followed by smaller screens on right. Once you have your main screen and smaller screens on right you can press right to change what screen you want almost full. Pressing down will take you back to original studio view.
  - iii. Picture-in-Picture mode - once selected will make your current channel the picture-in-picture channel. Simply press your center button then select another channel and the channel you select will be your main channel.
  - iv. To switch picture-in-picture just click center button / enter button and select picture-in-picture parameters. From this screen you can customize your picture-in-picture.
